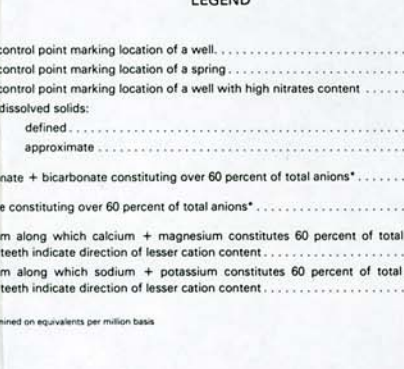

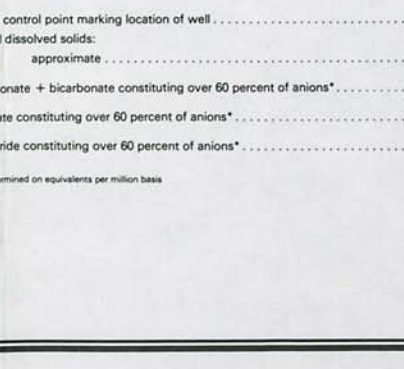
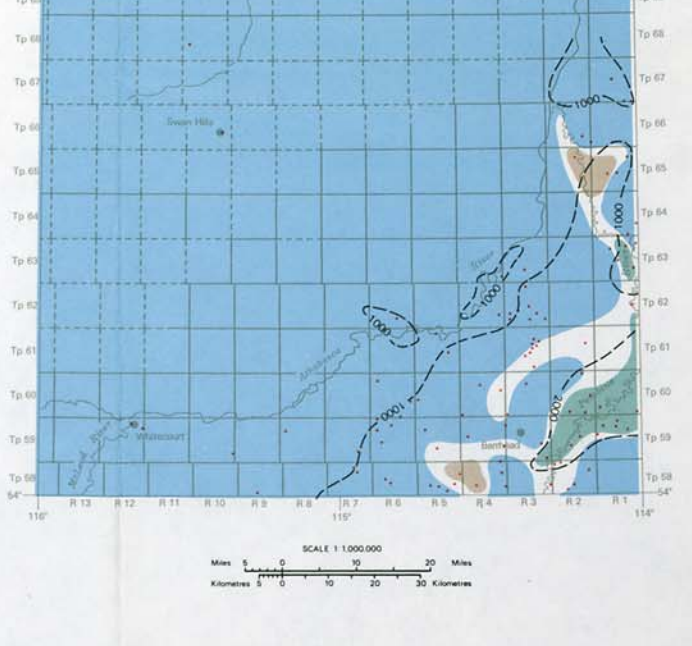
HYDROCHEMISTRY: WELLS LESS THAN 50 FEET (15 M) IN DEPTH
